FAQ's

Does it cost money to join Grapevine? It's completely free to create your account and make donations on Grapevine.

How are donations on Grapevine processed? The Grapevine Giving Foundation is the 501c3 public charity (EIN #87-2389502) organization associated with Grapevine. Our platform facilitates all donations through the foundation, providing immediate tax receipts to donors and enabling a fast & flexible process for receiving and granting donations.

How are donations secured? All Grapevine donates

All Grapevine donations are secured by bank-level, 256-bit encryption. We utilize SHA-256 RSA Encryption verified and signed by Let's Encrypt Authority X3.

Will donors receive a tax receipt upon their donation?

Yes, your donor will receive their tax receipt by email upon their donation. They can also track all of their donations and tax receipts in their Grapevine account.

What is Grapevine?

Grapevine is the only platform dedicated to Giving Circles. Never heard of a Giving Circle before? It's a group of people with shared values who come together to connect and make change. They pool their donations and decide as a group where they should go. Their connection, discussion, and collective gift transforms into meaningful engagement, community power, and real change. Giving Circles come in all shapes and sizes. They can have just a few members or thousands, they can support local nonprofits or national causes, they can collect \$10 donations or \$10,000 from their members.

How can my company sponsor or match my donation?

Many companies provide matching or employee directed donations to the nonprofit of an employee's choosing, or will cover fees for joining a networking group - these can include Grapevine! Start a conversation with your manager or HR/CSR department to either make the donation in your name, or to clarify your benefits and whether they will cover this for you if you aren't sure.

Here are some common ways that companies cover or match donations.

Directly on Grapevine: Use a company credit card to make a donation directly on Grapevine. Just head to your group page, select "Donate" and then add the payment information for your corporate card. You can also send the donation page URL directly to your manager or HR/CSR representative to make a payment via credit card or ACH direct deposit.

Through company donation portals, like Benevity: Make a donation directly to Grapevine via your company donation portal. Make the donation to Grapevine Giving Foundation, EIN #87-2389502. When making the donation, make sure to include your Giving Circle name as the purpose for your gift.

With a check: Make checks payable to Grapevine Giving Foundation and include the Giving Circle name as the purpose, and member name as the affiliation. Then mail the check to: Grapevine Giving Foundation, P.O. Box 23752, New York, NY 10087-3752.
